Bivocational Ministry Certificate (2023-24) Advising Sheet

The Bivocational Ministry Certificate is designed to assist bivocational ministers in improving their ministry skills and increasing their Biblical and theological knowledge. All courses required for the Bivocational Ministry Certificate are transferable to the B.A. in Ministry program.

This certificate is typically taken in three consecutive semesters beginning in spring, but may be started in spring or fall. Students may complete the certificate in as little as one year or may choose to take only one course a term for eight terms.
