

# OFF-CAMPUS SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Dear Student,

It is very important to remember to apply for ALL off-campus scholarships Annually that you are eligible for, especially if you have a financial need! PLUS, It's FREE money for you.

- ✚ In-house Endowment Scholarships are limited, therefore, **failure to apply for off-campus scholarships that you may be eligible for may affect the amount of the In-House scholarships that you may be awarded, which would leave you owing a larger amount for that academic year.**
- ✚ An off-campus scholarship application (which is between you and the company offering the scholarship) will be viewed as a good-will attempt on your part. Even if your application is denied, you may still receive more in-house aid for your effort.
- ✚ The receipt of an off-campus external scholarship will not affect your in-house awards as long as it does not create an over-award.
